- 1. Last week I taught *The Doctrine of the Names of Christ* and when the clock tolled 7:45 I was in the process of teaching the *Doctrine of Jesus Teaches*.
- 2. Before we return to that study, I want to give you opportunity to rebound.
- 3. I want to review some of that learned last week and then begin new material on page four.

Doctrine of Jesus Teaches

Matthew 21:23

When He entered the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came to Him while **He was teaching**, and said, "By what authority are You doing these things, and who gave You this authority?"

Matthew 26:55

At that time Jesus said to the crowds, "Have you come out with swords and clubs to arrest Me as you would against a robber? Every day I used to sit in the temple **teaching** and you did not seize Me.

Mark 12:35

And Jesus began to say, as **He taught** in the temple, "How is it that the scribes say that the Christ is the son of David?

Luke 19:47

And He was teaching daily in the temple; but the chief priests and the scribes and the leading men among the people were trying to destroy Him,

Luke 20:1

On one of the days **while He was teaching** the people in the temple and preaching the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders confronted Him,

Luke 21:37

Now during the day **He was teaching** in the temple, **but at evening** He would go out and spend the night on the mount that is called Olivet.

John 7:14

But when it was now the midst of the feast Jesus went up **into the temple**, and began to teach.

John 7:28

Then Jesus cried out **in the temple, teaching** and saying, "You both know Me and know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself, but He **who sent Me** is true, whom **you do not know**.

John 8:2

Early in the morning He came again **into the temple**, and all the people were coming to Him; and **He sat down and began to teach** them.

John 8:20

These words **He spoke in the treasury, as He taught in the temple**; and no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come.

Mark 14:49

"Every day I was with you in the temple teaching, and you did not seize Me; but this has taken place to fulfill the Scriptures."

Matthew 4:23

Jesus was going throughout all **Galilee**, **teaching in their synagogues** and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, **and healing** every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.

Matthew 9:35

Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues **and proclaiming the gospel** of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

Matthew 13:54

He came to **His hometown** and began **teaching** them **in their synagogue**, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and these miraculous powers?

Mark 1:21

They went into Capernaum; and immediately on the Sabbath He entered **the synagogue** and began **to teach**.

Mark 6:2

When the **Sabbath came**, **He began to teach in the synagogue**; and the many listeners were astonished, saying, "Where did this man get these things, and what is this wisdom given to Him, and such miracles as these performed by His hands?

Luke 4:15-16

And He began teaching in their synagogues and was praised by all. And He came to **Nazareth**, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, **He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath**, and stood up to read.

Luke 6:6

On another Sabbath He entered the synagogue and was teaching; and there was a man there whose right hand was withered.

Luke 13:10

And He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.

John 18:20

Jesus answered him, "I have spoken openly to the world; I always taught in synagogues and in the temple, where all the Jews come together; and I spoke nothing in secret.

John 6:59

These things He said in the **synagogue as He taught in Capernaum**.

Matthew 11:1

When Jesus had finished giving instructions to His disciples concerning John the Baptist, He departed **to teach** and preach in their cities.

Mark 6:6

And He wondered at their unbelief as **He taught** in each village.

Luke 13:22

And He was passing through from one city and village to another, **teaching**, **even** on His way to Jerusalem.

Mark 2:13

And He went out again by the seashore; and all the people were coming to Him, and He was **teaching** them.

Mark 6:34

When Jesus went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and He felt compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and **He began to teach them many things.**

Mark 10:1

Getting up, He went from there to the region of Judea and beyond the Jordan; crowds gathered around Him again, and, according to His custom, He once more **began to teach them**.

Mark 4:1

He began to teach again by the sea And such a very large crowd gathered to Him that He got into a boat in the sea and sat down; and the whole crowd was by the sea on the land.

<u>Luke 5:3</u>

And He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little way from the land. And **He sat down and began teaching** the people from the boat.

Matthew 5:2

He opened His mouth and began to teach them, saying,

Mark 9:31

For He was **teaching His disciples** and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, **He will rise three days later**."

Luke 11:1

It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "**Lord**, **teach us to pray** just as John also taught his disciples."

Luke 5:17

One day **He was teaching**; and there were some Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting there, who had come from every village of Galilee and Judea and from Jerusalem; and the power of the Lord was present for Him to perform healing.

Matthew 7:28

When Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were amazed at His teaching;

Matthew 22:33

When the crowds heard this, they were astonished at His teaching.

Mark 1:22

They were amazed at His teaching; **for He was teaching them as one having authority**, and not as the scribes.

Mark 11:18

The chief priests and the scribes heard this, and began seeking how to destroy Him; for they were afraid of Him, for **the whole crowd was astonished at His teaching.**

Luke 4:32

They were **amazed at his teaching, because his message had authority**.

Mark 2:2

And many were gathered together, so that there was no longer room, not even near the door; and He was **speaking the word to them**.

Matthew 22:16

And they sent their disciples to Him, along with the Herodians, saying, "**Teacher**, we know that You are truthful and teach the way of God in truth, and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any.

Mark 12:14

They came and said to Him, "**Teacher**, we know that You are truthful and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any, **but teach the way of God in truth.** Is it lawful to pay a poll-tax to Caesar, or not?

Luke 20:21

They questioned Him, saying, "Teacher, we know that You speak and teach correctly, and You are **not partial to any, but teach the way of God in truth.**

Luke 10:39

She had a sister called Mary, who was seated at the Lord's feet, listening to His word.

Luke 13:26

"Then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and **You taught in our streets'**;

Luke 23:5

But they kept on insisting, saying, "**He stirs up the people, teaching all over Judea**, starting from Galilee even as far as this place."

John 7:35

The **Jews then said to one another**, "Where does this man intend to go that we will not find Him? **He is not intending to go to the Dispersion among the Greeks, and teach the Greeks, is He?**
